Play

Play becomes increasingly intricate with more complex rules devised and explained among peers. Utilising fine and gross motor skills adeptly, children create detailed structures indoors and outdoors using tools and equipment.

Throughout Year 1, children demonstrate higher levels of independence and autonomous learning. Equipped with fluent language and organisational skills, they independently manage many aspects of their learning through the Plan ,Do, Review cycle of the day. They confidently explore various resources and materials once they initiate and plan their project work. The children demonstrate an awareness of healthy habits and foods, sharing this knowledge amongst their peers.

Communication:

Reading and writing become more focused modes of communication during this year. Daily Phonics activities enable the practice and development of more complex aspects of spelling, grammar, and pronunciation. Children are encouraged to write varying length stories and recounts of their experiences, fully supported and guided. They read books daily.

Physical Development:

Children exhibit confidence and agility, engaging in target, invasion, and evasion games. They display excellent hand-eye coordination, readily attempting new activities and sports with increased success. They participate in specialist Taekwondo, P.E. and swimming.

Literacy:

Year 1 children evolve into confident readers and writers. They possess a more thorough understanding of phonics, including alternative methods of reading and





creating sounds. Their familiarity with sight words (tricky words) facilitates their progress in reading fluency and fluidity.
